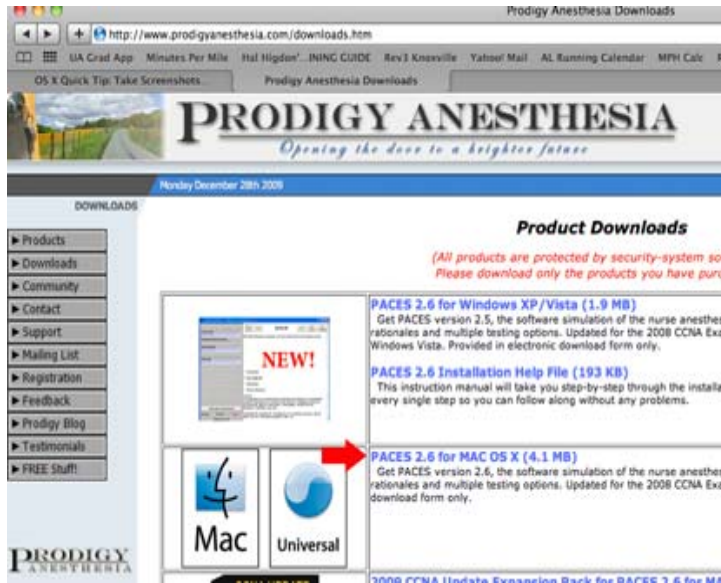

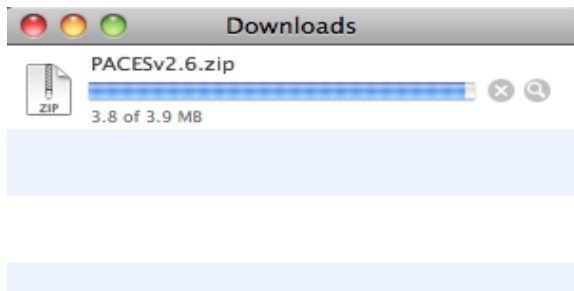

Mac OSX Software Installation Guide

1. If you did not download the PACES 2.6 for Mac OSX file during the checkout process, you may download it at www.prodigyanesthesia.com/downloads.htm



On clicking the link, you should see the file downloading in your Downloads screen.



2. The PACES installer program should launch automatically showing the screen below. If it does not, then open your Downloads folder in Finder and double-click the PACESv2.6.zip file. When the screen below displays, click Continue to begin the installation process.



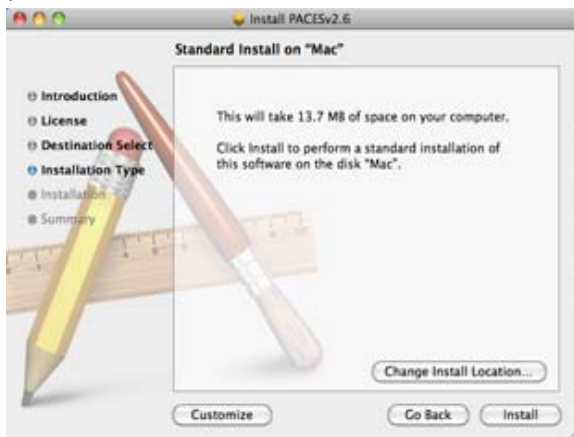
3. The next screen displays the license agreement.



4. Click Continue which will bring up a dialog asking if you agree to the license agreement. If you do, then click Agree.



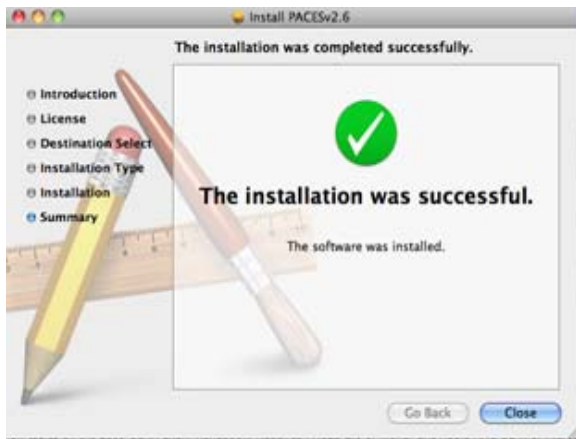
5. The next screen displays the hard drive requirements and offers to install the program on the default drive. If you wish to choose another drive then select Change Install Option.



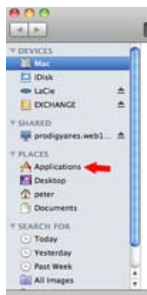
6. Depending upon your settings, you may be asked to login as administrator to proceed with installation.



7. The files will begin copying and you will be presented with the successful installation screen.



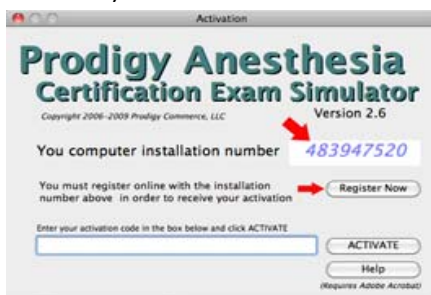
8. Click Close. Then open Finder on your Mac and navigate to the Applications folder.



9. Scroll through the applications until you see the PACES icon and double-click it.



10. You will be presented with the PACES activation screen. On it is displayed a unique installation number. The number in the image is the one generated for my computer. Your installation number will be different. It is this installation number that is needed to generate your computer specific activation code. To register, click the Register button, which will open up the registration page at our website (an active internet connection is needed, but it doesn't necessarily have to be the same computer as the one on which you are installing the software).



11. On the registration page, fill out the personal information. We need it to identify your account and authorize an activation on it. If the personal information isn't completed, the registration will be ignored. Most importantly, be sure to enter the installation number from your PACES activation screen into the corresponding box on the registration form. Make sure that your installation number is entered exactly as it appears on the activation

screen. If even a single digit is missing or transposed, your activation code will not work.

12. After completing your registration, click Submit. We will email the activation code back to you. Please enter it into blank line at the bottom of the PACES activation screen and click ACTIVATE. You will then be presented with the PACES main screen.
